TIMING BULLETIN

Timing transponder collection and return

Mylaps TranX-MX (ORANGE coloured) transponders will be used at this event. Transponders will be available for collection at sign-on.

Mounting brackets and cable ties will be provided. **Transponders to be mounted on the RIGHT-HAND SIDE of the bike.**

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is properly mounted for all sessions (including practice). Competitors found not to have transponders properly mounted, may be black-flagged from the session or have times excluded after the end of the session. Computime's back-up procedures ensure that accurate times are recorded if any competitor is found to have a faulty timing transponder.

Event staff will endeavor to collect transponders as riders complete their last event on Saturday, however failing that, it is the competitor's responsibility to return the transponder to the race secretary office.

Intermediate sector timing

As well as the timing loop at the finish line to determine full lap times and positions, two intermediate timing points will be installed around the track to provide intermediate positioning and projected lap time information. The split time information will be available as detailed below.

Live timing and results service

Printed results

Printed results will be displayed in the rider marshalling area. However, competitors can also access the results from www.computime.com.au.

Television based Race Display

Computime's television-based Race Display showing live timing information will be connected to the circuit television system inside the arena and displayed on the "big screens" when live vision is not available.

Local intranet

Computime's local wireless intranet site will be set-up and should (signal strength pending) be available in the pit and mechanic signaling area.

The system (accessed via tablet, smartphone, or laptop) features:

- All results from the meeting (only minutes after each session is completed) in HTML format (for viewing on your web browser) and PDF (Acrobat) format for you to save and print later.
- A live timing display application (for the session currently in progress).
- Additional reports available for download that are not normally photocopied for competitors (intermediate lap times, lap sheets, lap charts, fastest lap sequence and points).

To access the local intranet, connect to the **COMPUTIME** network and enter www.localtiming.com as the web browser address.

Internet timing

For family and friends at home, and to access the same features as the local intranet detailed above outside the arena (including the pit area), Computime will be able to bring you live timing on the internet.
